Registration Dates and Prices:

Biennial WMEA state conferences are open to music educators, college and high school music students, and others interested in music education. Registration includes access to conference presentations, exhibits, and musical performances including All-State Jazz and Junior All-State concerts. Meals, Sunday's All-State concert tickets and extra All-State Jazz tickets are available at additional cost.

Delegates may register online, via mail, or on site. Pre-registration prices are available online and via mail (postmarked) through Monday January 22, 2018. **After January 22nd, you must register on site.**

Information for Student Registrations: Collegiate MEA Members must be students; full or part-time school music teachers are not eligible for the student rate. Collegiate/high school non-members registering on site must present their student ID to be eligible for the student rate.

Additional Information on Concert Tickets: Concert tickets for family members Grade 8 and younger are complimentary. Each badge purchased allows for one discounted \$5 Sunday concert ticket; additional tickets are \$20 each. Concert tickets purchased at the door before all concerts are \$25 each. One ticket allows entry into all three Sunday concerts. Badge holders have free entry to the All-State Jazz Concert, but may buy additional tickets for \$20 with registration or \$25 at the door.

Payment Options:

Credit card: Credit cards from school, school district, or individual delegate

Purchase Order: From school or school district; hard copy required for mail-in and on-site registrations.

Check: From school, school district, or individual delegate; \$25 charge for returned checks

Cash: US currency only; **on site only**

Multiple payment methods and changes: If you wish to split payment between yourself and your school/district, or need to make changes after submission, please email registration@wmea.org or phone the WMEA office.

Online registrations paid by credit card are processed and emailed a receipt immediately upon submission.

Online registrations paid by purchase order, and all mailed registrations are processed and billed within five business days of receipt (mail)/submission (online). After processing, a receipt will be emailed to the delegate.

On-site registrations will be processed on site, and a receipt will be emailed to the delegate.
